

Send shortcut to desktop button

You already have shortcuts on your desktop - icons that open certain programs when you double-click on them. By clicking on the computer icon on our home page, you can send a shortcut to your desktop. The shortcut will open to our website when you double-click on it. This allows you quick and direct access to our website without having to open your browser (Internet Explorer, Firefox, Opera, etc.) or any other web pages first.

Click on the desktop icon. Select, "Save". This will open a window which will prompt you to select a destination. Proper destinations are as follows:

Windows XP users - Computer/(C:)/All Users/Documents and Settings/Desktop

Windows Vista users - Computer/(C:)/Users/"your username"/Desktop

Select the proper destination according to your Windows version. Then click on "Save" again. If executed properly, our website icon will appear on your desktop among your other shortcut icons. Double-click on it to open our website.

Problems Loading Pages

Occasionally, pages and page elements do not load completely or correctly. Sometimes the error seems to have no cause. If this happens, refresh your page by clicking on the circular arrow in your browser toolbar next to the address window. Additionally, some browser versions block some page features. This is a good defense against security threats, but our site contains no spyware, adware or malicious programs. When this happens, you will see a yellowish bar appear at the top of your screen. Click on it, and select "Allow Blocked Content". Lastly, your computer may block pop-ups if you click on any links within the gadgets on our home page. Again scroll your mouse over the yellow bar and click. Select "Temporarily Allow Pop-ups" or "Always Allow Pop-ups From This Site..." If you choose the second option also click "Yes" to confirm. Click on the gadget link again, and the pop-up should work.
